Christ is Risen!

Every day, often multiple times a day, we pray the words "give us this day our daily bread." According to the Fathers of the Church this "bread" has two specific meanings: 1. The Holy Eucharist, 2. The basic necessities of life. Both of these types of "bread" are in focus in the Masses this weekend.

At the 10 AM Mass seventeen (17) of our children are making their First Holy Communion. These children will receive the Bread of Life for the first time as they continue their Christian Initiation. Also today in the first reading at Mass we hear that some of the widows in the apostolic community were "being neglected" and not receiving their share of bread.

At the back of our church are bins to collect personal hygiene items for those who have trouble accessing basic necessities of life. It was not just the widows of the early Church who did not have enough, it is also those who live in our communities.

How do we share our daily spiritual bread? Do we invite others to come to Mass with us? Give a ride to someone who has difficulty? Share with a family member our experience of the Eucharist? How do we share our daily physical bread? Go shopping for someone else? Volunteer with Sr. Kathleen's "Soup's On" ministry? Try to start an outreach in our parish?

I know that we need to give just as we have received. How might God be calling you to share your daily bread?

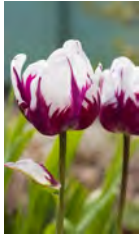

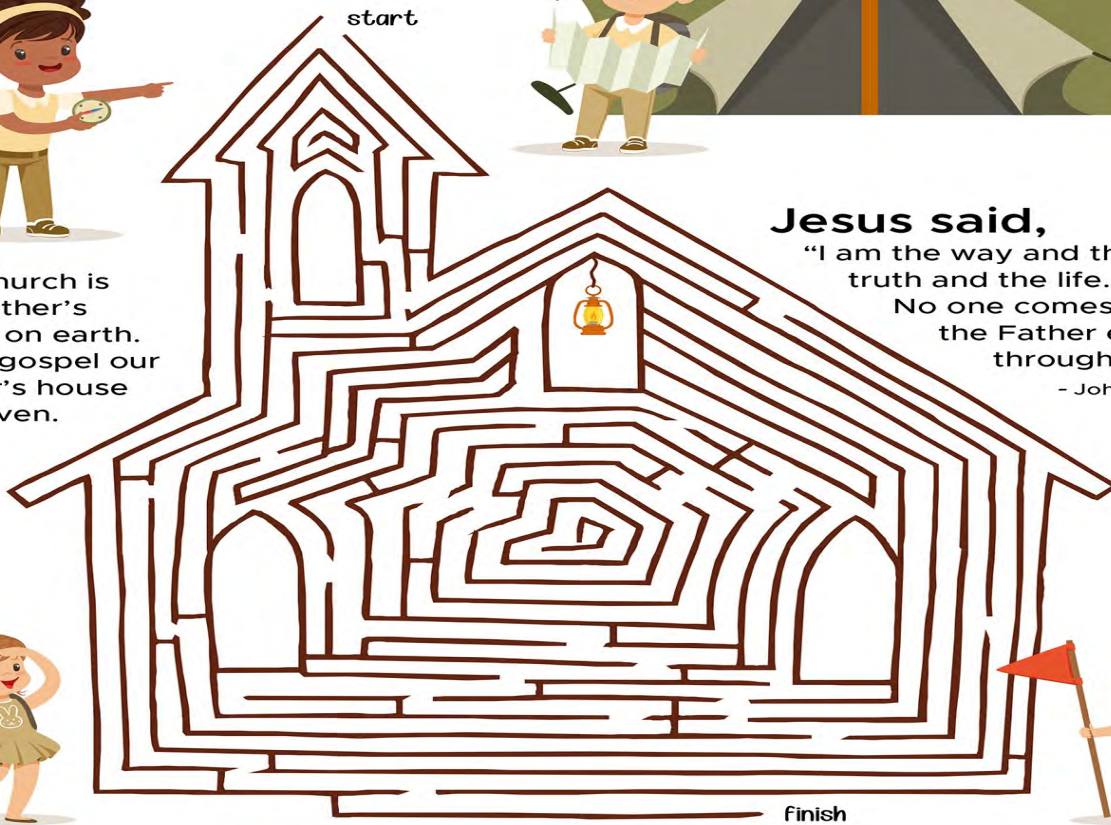
