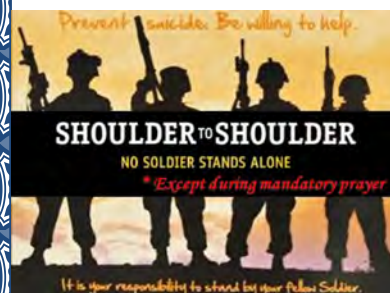



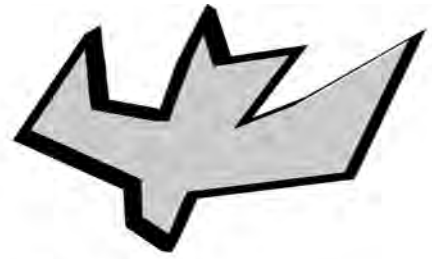

Our “Set a Plate for Jesus” ministry has delivered over 7,100 meals to Catholic Charities and Branches since November 15th, 2021.

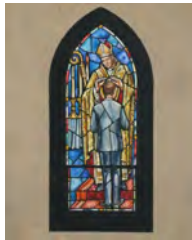
Please take part...it’s so easy! Pick up a container (or 2) in the vestibules of our churches and fill them with the food from your table, freeze them, and return them to either church.
