Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday following 9am Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9am Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF

EUCCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to or email one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

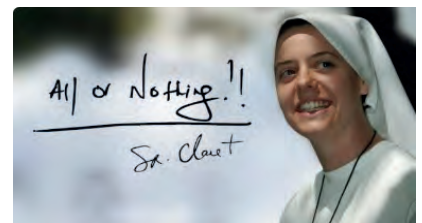

Parish History (Cont'd.)

St. Raymond Regional School

Father Regan began the task of building a parish school with the permission of the Camden Diocese and the purchase of a "turkey" farm for \$29,000 located at the corner of Ocean Ave. and Bayshore Ave, across from the Church. The lot was cleared and construction began in 1962 at a cost for the school and convent of \$282,059. Many fund raisers were held with such entertainers as Cozy Morley and Jack Steck (of the Starlit Stairway in Woodside Park). Once completed, the parish lacked the funds to furnish the school and many items were donated by parishioners for the school and the convent.

(We will return to our school history beginning in the next edition of our bulletin.)

APRIL IS NATIONAL CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH

In our parish we have over 80 employees and volunteers who have completed the required background check and training and who serve our children as: priests, school personnel, volunteers in our - Religious Education program, St. Vincent de Paul society, Christ Child society, Knights of Columbus, altar servers, sports, choir, chaperones and food pantry.

Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica Los Siete Sacramentos de la Iglesia

Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucaristía, Penitencia, Unción de los enfermos, Orden Sacerdotal y Matrimonio

Capítulo Primero

Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 2 EL SACRAMENTO DE LA CONFIRMACIÓN

1285 Con el Bautismo y la Eucaristía, el sacramento de la Confirmación constituye el conjunto de los "sacramentos de la iniciación cristiana", cuya unidad debe ser salvaguardada. Es preciso, pues, explicar a los fieles que la recepción de este sacramento es necesaria para la plenitud de la gracia bautismal (cf Ritual de la Confirmación, Prenotandos 1). En efecto, a los bautizados "el sacramento de la Confirmación los une más íntimamente a la Iglesia y los enriquece con una fortaleza especial del Espíritu Santo. De esta forma quedan obligados aún más, como auténticos testigos de Cristo, a extender y defender la fe con sus palabras y sus obras" (LG 11; cf Ritual de la Confirmación, Prenotandos 2):

I LA CONFIRMACIÓN EN LA ECONOMÍA DE LA SALVACIÓN

1286 En el Antiguo Testamento, los profetas anunciaron que el Espíritu del Señor reposaría sobre el Mesías esperado (cf. Is 11,2) para realizar su misión salvífica (cf Lc 4,16-22; Is 61,1). El descenso del Espíritu Santo sobre Jesús en su Bautismo por Juan fue el signo de que Él era el que debía venir, el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios (Mt 3,13-17; Jn 1,33-34). Habiendo sido concedido por obra del Espíritu Santo, toda su vida y toda su misión se realizan en una comunión total con el Espíritu Santo que el Padre le da "sin medida" (Jn 3,34).

1287 Ahora bien, esta plenitud del Espíritu no debía permanecer únicamente en el Mesías, sino que debía ser comunicada a todo el pueblo mesiánico (cf Ez 36,25-27; Jl 3,1-2). En repetidas ocasiones Cristo prometió esta efusión del Espíritu (cf Lc 12,12; Jn 3,5-8; 7,37-39; 16,7-15; Hch 1,8), promesa que realizó primero el día de Pascua (Jn 20,22) y luego, de manera más manifiesta el día de Pentecostés (cf Hch 2,1-4). Llenos del Espíritu Santo, los Apóstoles comienzan a proclamar "las maravillas de Dios" (Hch 2,11) y Pedro declara que esta efusión del Espíritu es el signo de los tiempos mesiánicos (cf Hch 2, 17-18). Los que creyeron en la predicación apostólica y se hicieron bautizar, recibieron a su vez el don del Espíritu Santo (cf Hch 2,38).
