Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday following 9am Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9am Mass; Fridays at 7pm prior to 8pm Mass in Spanish. Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the 4pm Vigil Mass at St. John of God or after the 7pm Sunday Mass at St. Raymond. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call our DSF for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to or email Fr. Hostios to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. Hostios to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

HIS WORD TODAY

**Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time
September 13, 2026**

"Forgive your neighbor's injustice, then when you pray, your own sins will be forgiven. Could anyone nourish anger against another and expect healing from the Lord? Could anyone refuse mercy to another like himself, can he seek pardon for his own sins?... Think of the commandments, hate not your neighbor, remember the Most High's covenant, and overlook faults."... "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive?""

As the Lord speaks in these passages today, I ask: 'Which is more difficult, to ask forgiveness or to forgive?' Forgiveness is an attitude of love and concern to set things right. The adage, 'forgive and forget' is noble, but it is hard to forget. A wise spiritual guide said it another way, 'forgive and remember without bitterness.'

I leave the hurt behind and don't allow the scar to keep me from offering the healing which someone else seeks. How powerful is the gift of forgiveness. May we use it well.

FOLLOWING THE BEATITUDES THE VINCENTIAN WAY

In the Gospel of Matthew 5:3–12, we read the Sermon on the Mount, where Jesus teaches the Beatitudes: blessed are the poor, those who mourn, the merciful, the peacemakers, and all who seek to live with humble and faithful hearts.

We are charged by Jesus to live the Beatitudes and many of us do through our volunteer time, by supporting our church and various ministries and organizations.

Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica

Los Siete Sacramentos de la Iglesia

Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucarística, Penitencia, Unción de los enfermos, Orden Sacerdotal y Matrimonio

Capítulo Primero

Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 3 EL SACRAMENTO DE LA EUCARISTÍA

1326 Finalmente, por la celebración eucarística nos unimos ya a la liturgia del cielo y anticipamos la vida eterna cuando Dios será todo en todos (cf 1 Co 15,28).

1327 En resumen, la Eucaristía es el compendio y la suma de nuestra fe: "Nuestra manera de pensar armoniza con la Eucaristía, y a su vez la Eucaristía confirma nuestra manera de pensar" (San Ireneo de Lyon, *Adversus haereses* 4, 18, 5).

II EL NOMBRE DE ESTE SACRAMENTO

1328 La riqueza inagotable de este sacramento se expresa mediante los distintos nombres que se le da. Cada uno de estos nombres evoca alguno de sus aspectos. Se le llama:

Eucaristía porque es acción de gracias a Dios. Las palabras eucharistein (Lc 22,19; 1 Co 11,24) y eulogein (Mt 26,26; Mc 14,22) recuerdan las bendiciones judías que proclaman —sobre todo durante la comida— las obras de Dios: la creación, la redención y la santificación.

1329 *Banquete del Señor* (cf 1 Co 11,20) porque se trata de la Cena que el Señor celebró con sus discípulos la víspera de su pasión y de la anticipación del banquete de bodas del Cordero (cf Ap 19,9) en la Jerusalén celestial.

Fracción del pan porque este rito, propio del banquete judío, fue utilizado por Jesús cuando bendecía y distribuía el pan como cabeza de familia (cf Mt 14,19; 15,36; Mc 8,6.19), sobre todo en la última Cena (cf Mt 26,26; 1 Co 11,24). En este gesto los discípulos lo reconocerán después de su resurrección (Lc 24,13-35), y con esta expresión los primeros cristianos designaron sus asambleas eucarísticas (cf Hch 2,42.46; 20,7.11). Con él se quiere significar que todos los que comen de este único pan, partido, que es Cristo, entran en comunión con él y forman un solo cuerpo en él (cf 1 Co 10,16-17).

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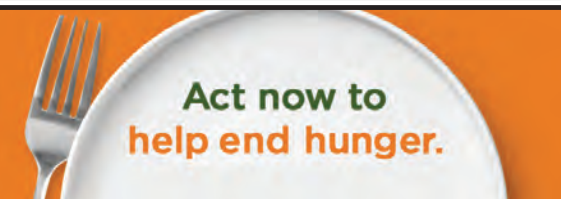
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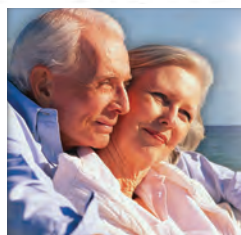


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
